## **Basil Marinade**

1/3 cup extra virgin olive oil  
1/3 cup fresh lemon juice  
1/3 cup boiling water  
3 cloves garlic, peeled  
1 large bunch fresh basil, stemmed  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper  
Combine all ingredients in blender and process into a smooth paste. Store in fridge (up to 3 days)
