#### **DESCRIPTIONS OF VOLUNTEER PROGRAMS:**

### **Children's Department**

Teens entering grades 8 to freshman year of college may apply to assist with Children's Department online activities. Teens must be self-motivated and responsible and should enjoy working with kids. Registration and orientation are required.

## **Teen Department**

Teens entering grades 8 to freshman year of college may apply to assist with Teen Department online activities. Teens must be self-motivated and responsible and should expect to collaborate with Teen Department staff as well as with other teens. Registration and orientation are required.

#### uCreate Space

Teens entering grades 8 through freshman year of college may apply to volunteer with the uCreate Volunteer Team. In lieu of working on-site in the Library's makerspace, uCreate volunteers should expect to: assist with planning and facilitating online uCreate activities for all ages, participate in an active group chat with other volunteers, and expand their creativity and digital literacy (by learning about 3D printing, coding, gaming, robotics, and more). Teens must be self-motivated and responsible and should have an interest in technology. Registration and orientation are required.
