Dear Friends and Neighbors,

It has been my pleasure to serve on the Stratford Library Board for over 31 years and to return this year as President.

Here are some highlights from 2024-25. The Library:

- Added a new Spanish-language collection for Teens
- Modernized one of the Library's elevators using Town-authorized Federal funding.
- Updated Teen Services furniture using Federal ARPA funds arranged through State Senator Gresko's office.
- Trained Adult Services staff in effective services and program planning for people with autism.

This year, the Stratford Library welcomed 2,500 visitors every week. The use of JobNow, a career and job search resource, increased by 116%. Individual use of conference and study rooms increased by 34%. People borrowed items, participated in programs, engaged with the uCreate makerspace, received help with technology, attended meetings, used free Wi-Fi, read, studied, worked, and played. There is no other public space in Stratford offering as many free services for all community members.

Our hardworking Library Board supported the Library through advocacy and close collaboration with Town Officials to ensure we serve all of Stratford's residents fully. Because of our dedicated team of Library workers, we are one of Connecticut's top 25 busiest public ibraries. Our donors and volunteers raised more money than ever through the Gala, the Associates campaign, and the annual Book Sale. Finally, our Library patrons responded powerfully to our community survey, helping us improve our programs and services to better meet everyone's needs so that everyone in Stratford can learn, create, and share.
