Corporate Tax Credit Program



CT NEIGHBORHOOD ASSISTANCE ACT

Is designed to provide funding for tax-exempt organizations, such as the Stratford Library Association, by offering a corporate business tax credit to businesses that make cash contributions to approved entities. The CT Department of Revenue Service approved the Library's energy-efficiency program for \$128,073 for 100% tax credit.



ASK YOUR TAX PREPARER!

To take full advantage of this program, contact your tax preparer to ensure eligibility. The 100% tax credit may be applied against the following state taxes: Chapter 207, 208, 209, 210, 211, and 212.

The timeline is critical. Stratford Library will receive state approval by September 1, 2026.

Business firms must submit the one-page Form-NAA02 between September 15 and October 1, 2026.

DRS will then issue a program approval letter to business firms to make qualifying contributions. Full DRS information here:

HOW TO BENEFIT

Monetary contributions between \$250 to \$150,000 qualify for the 100% CT tax credit.
